The Villages Charter School operates by a charter agreement approved by the Sumter County Board of Education and the Florida State Department of Education.

Unlike traditional county schools, our enrollment criteria is based upon the place of employment of one of the parents/guardians rather than the geographic address of their home. The Villages Charter School ("VCS") is a Charter-in-the-Workplace.

Parent Involvement

At The Villages Charter School, parent involvement is valued and creates a great community atmosphere. Categories of Enrollment

- 1 Businesses directly part of The Villages and affiliated companies.
- 2 Businesses that are direct sub-contractors to the developer.
- 3 Businesses that lease directly or own a business site within The Villages from The Villages Commercial Property Management.
- 4 Businesses that own a permanent business site purchased from a non-Villages entity or lease from a non-Villages entity within The Villages.

Buffalo Adventures

The Buffalo Adventures program provides a safe, supervised environment full of enriching and age-appropriate activities for VCS students in grades K-12.
