

TEE & Cardioversion

You are scheduled for an upcoming cardiology procedure. Please follow all the instructions below to prevent your procedure from being cancelled.

Prior to Surgery:

- You will need to arrive at the hospital 90 minutes prior to your scheduled time to register with the Cath Lab.
- The Cath Lab will also call you prior to your procedure to verify the arrival time and the time of your procedure.
- If you are on a GLP-1 injection, please stop 7 days prior to procedure. For Oral Form, please stop 1 day prior to procedure.
 - Examples: Ozempic, Wegovy, Mounjaro, Trulicity, Saxenda, Semaglutide, Dulaglutide, Tirezepatide, and Liraglutide.

Day of Surgery:

- Do NOT eat or drink anything for 8 hours prior to your procedure, definitely NO caffeine.
 - However, you should take your daily medications as usual but with small sips of water, rather than a full glass (unless told otherwise).
 - Even if you currently take a prescription blood thinner, you should also take that medication as you normally would.
- Do not bring any jewelry with you. All jewelry must be removed prior to the procedure, or your procedure could be canceled; this includes wedding bands, watches, earrings, necklaces, bracelets, and ankle bracelets.
- Wear warm, loose, comfortable clothing.
- Wear comfortable low-heeled shoes.
- Bring your Advanced Directives (if you have), Insurance cards and Photo ID.
- If you wear glasses, contact lenses, dentures, or a hearing aid and wish to have them with you, that is permissible. Please bring containers for them so they can be stored during your procedure.
- You will need a driver to bring you home from your procedure. You will NOT be allowed to drive yourself home.
